INTRODUCTION

The Brunswick Lodge of Masons, United #8 AF&AM, is offering two \$1000 educational grants. One will be awarded to a senior at Brunswick High School and one to a senior at Mount Ararat High School. The educational grants are to be used for the students' post high school education in any accredited college, university, or trade school.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The eligibility for this educational grant is as follows:

- Member of the 2022 senior class of either Brunswick High School or Mount Ararat.
- Grade point average of at least B- in either a vocational/technical or college preparatory curriculum.
- Continuing to any accredited post high school education (traditional college or VocTech)
- Student submits letter to United Lodge educational grant committee via the school guidance officer describing civic involvement, service to community, and life aspirations.
- Attach copy of school transcript
- Deadline for receipt of the application by the guidance offices is March 11th and we will pick them up on March 14th.

CRITERIA

United Lodge #8 Educational Grant Committee will be making the selection and the recipients will be contacted directly by the Lodge. Criteria for selection are civic involvement, service to community, life aspirations and minimum grade point average.

AWARD

The award of the educational grant will be made in the form of a presentation at a school recognition ceremony or a stated communication of the Lodge.

ADMINISTRATION

The educational grant recipient will receive a check in the amount of \$1000 at the time of award that may be used for any school related expenses
